- 1. <u>INTRODUCTION OF NEW MEMBER</u> Pat Sanley was introduced as a new Civic Center Commission Member.
- 2. <u>MANAGER'S REPORT</u> Sprinkler system has now been adjusted, some heads replaced, operating not optimally but well enough to get by with replaced sprinkler heads. H & S inspected plumbing and HVAC units and will send estimates for updates and repairs and to be compliant with ADA requirements. Water fountain replacement with bottle filling waiting on cost estimate. HVAC, no major worries at this time but may not have a long lifespan left. Could be repaired/replaced as needed. Replacing of boiler isn't an optimal solution. Rumery will submit estimate for removing dead plants and bushes, fixing areas of lawn that need repaired, and fix sunken areas. Report on room utilization great start to data capture. New groups starting recurring meetings. Trying to hire one more part time employee as others return to college, etc. New microwave purchased for upstairs kitchenette. Will need to remind mowers to be sure and keep up with mowing on South side of building across the street as well.

Current equity balance is \$919072.55 with expenses totaling \$11855 (estimated) for August and estimated \$10000 for September.

4. <u>REPORT OF COMMITTEE ON POSSIBLE RENOVATION AND REDECORATING ORGINAL</u> <u>BUILDING UPSTAIRS IN FIREPLACE AND/OR BATHROOMS – Discussion/Action</u>

Discussion ensued about obligations of the Civic Center Commission and course of action for future plans. Ken Morgan has reached out to the attorneys that submitted opinions (Blevins and Hoffschneider) to finalize next steps and decide if/when SCCDP occupancy will be decided by the courts.
