UTILITY PERMIT REQUIREMENTS - CHECKLIST

1. The Applicant shall furnish the City of Seward with a Certificate of Insurance in accordance with the insurance requirements stated below, before starting any work on City right-of-way.
 - a. All Certificates shall be on the standard ACORD CERTIFICATE OF LIABILITY INSURANCE form, showing specific limits of insurance coverage, and showing the City of Seward as an additional insured.
 - b. All liability insurance policies shall be written on an "occurrence" basis only.
 - c. All insurance coverages are to be placed with Insurers authorized to do business in the State of Nebraska.
 - d. The minimum acceptable limits of coverage are as follows:

- Bodily Injury and Property Damage:	- \$1,000,000 each occurrence
	- \$2,000,000 aggregate
- Personal Injury Damage:	- \$1,000,000 each occurrence
- Contractual Liability:	- \$1,000,000 each occurrence
- Products Liability and Completed Operations:	- \$1,000,000 each occurrence
- Automobile Liability:	- \$1,000,000 each occurrence
- Worker's Compensation and Employer's Liability:	- \$1,000,000 each occurrence
2. **\$5000 Performance Bond is required.**
3. The Applicant, or his Contractor, shall comply with all requirements of the Nebraska One-Call system, and shall notify the Digger's Hotline of Nebraska (1-800-331-5666) prior to any excavation in the City right-of-way. Damages to any utilities, either on or adjacent to City right-of-way, shall be repaired at the expense of the Applicant or his Contractor.
4. Future roadway construction work could necessitate relocation of utilities. Those utility relocation costs shall be borne by the utility owner, in conformance with Chapter 6 of the Seward City Code.
5. Areas disturbed during construction shall be restored to pre-construction condition as much as practical. This includes compaction of the backfill to a density equal to or greater than the surrounding soil, replacing road and driveway surfacing materials lost during construction, and seeding of disturbed areas.
6. Trees in the right-of-way shall be preserved wherever possible. Trees and brush removed to facilitate utility construction shall be properly disposed of.
7. Paved road crossings shall be dry bored. All utility pipes and encasements shall conform to Nebraska State Highway Standards.
8. All trenches shall be backfilled the same day the trench was excavated, except for the portion where the work is to be continued the next day. The portion left open for work continuation shall be protected by barricades and flashing lights at night. No open trenches in the roadway will be allowed at night.
9. All barricading, flagmen, warning signs, etc. shall conform to the current *Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices*.
10. No equipment shall be left unattended on public right-of-way. No equipment shall interfere with or block traffic control devices.
11. SUBMIT A SEPARATE SITE PLAN AND THREE (3) COMPLETE SET OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR ALL UTILITY CONSTRUCTION PROPOSED IN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY. INCLUDE SETBACK INFORMATION FROM R-O-W LINES AND SEPARATION DISTANCE FROM OTHER UTILITIES.
12. Other requirements by City of Seward: Notification must be made to property owners along the proposed construction work prior to the start of the project.
