

City of Seward - City Seal Design Contest

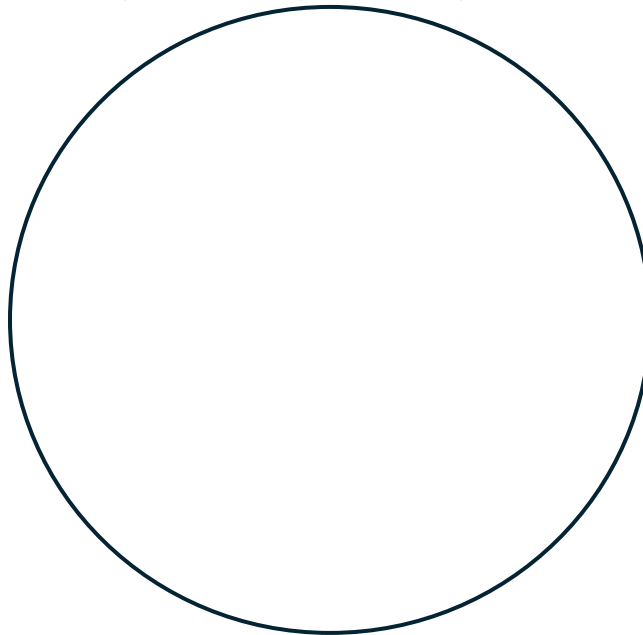
The City of Seward is launching an exciting City Seal Design Contest. We are asking current and former residents of all ages to help create a meaningful design that represents our community. The winning design will go before the City Council for final approval and if adopted it will become the new official seal of the City of Seward.

City seals are used to represent the legal verification of documents and acts of the city council. They are often designed to depict historical events or location attributes that are meaningful to the community. The submission doesn't need to be perfect; it just needs to be your own. With your artwork submission, please include a brief explanation of your artwork and how it represents Seward, Nebraska.

Every entry gets a prize – when you drop off your design. The top 3 selections, in each category, will receive a \$10 prize. The winner of the City of Seward Seal Design Contest will get a \$25 prize, a framed copy of their submission and a certificate signed by the Mayor.

Artwork submissions must be turned into City Hall, 537 Main Street, or emailed to info@cityofsewardne.gov by Friday, May 1, 2026. Top 3 winners in each category will be contacted individually. Winning design will be revealed during the 4th of July celebration.
